

Departmental Activities



On 5.8.2019, Department of Geography organised local field trip to visit Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park, Darjeeling to the undergraduate students of 2nd Semester. In this field trip 44 students participated and explore all the flora and fauna collection in this park. Our students could able to explore their knowledge by visiting in this park specially on Exsitu Conservation and Captive Breeding of endangered Himalayan animal species, Initiating applied research on animal biology, behaviour and health care.



The students of 6th semester were taken to field visit on 5.9.2019 at Happy Valley Tea Estate. As plantation is in the syllabus, the students can poster their knowledge by visualising the process of tea plucking, tea processing and packaging. This tea estate is spread over 177 hectares (440 acres), at a height of 2,100 metres (6,900 ft). The bushes in the garden are very old — the minimum age is 80 years, and some are 150 years old. Very little re-plantation has been done in the recent past. Situated around 3 km north of town, below Hill Cart Road, accessible via Lochnager Road from Chowk Bazaar, this tea estate is the closest tea estate to Darjeeling town, and tourists often visit the garden.
