# Student Satisfaction Survey Report 

(2021-2022)

Student satisfaction surveys are an important tool for measuring the effectiveness of education and identifying areas for improvement. By gathering feedback from students about their experiences in the classroom, the College can gain valuable insights into what is working well and what needs to be changed. The Institution regularly takes feedback from the students regarding teaching -learning experience and College Infrastructure. This feedback helps the College to work on the shortcomings in its work as well as to make informed decisions about curriculum development, teaching methods, and resource allocation.

Conducting a student satisfaction survey can also improve communication and build trust between students and teachers. By giving students a voice and actively seeking their input, educators can demonstrate that they are committed to creating a positive learning environment. This can increase student engagement and motivation, leading to improved academic performance and greater student success.

The College resumed the offline classes in the month of November 2021.The opening of classes after the prolonged period of Covid-19 induced lockdown led to the blended mode of teaching-learning. Both the online and offline classes started simultaneously. This feedback survey is focused on both the online and offline mode of teaching-learning.

## THE RESONDENTS

The Student Satisfaction Survey for the year 2021-2022 was conducted with the help of the questionnaire survey. A total of 2251 students out of 3250 attempted the questionnaire and gave us feedback on the teaching-learning and infrastructural facilities of the college. About $69 \%$ of Students responded to the feedback from both the Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses.

The questionnaire was divided into three heads- teaching-learning facilities (Educational feedback), Administrative Infrastructure and Support and Extracurricular activities.
91.9\% of Undergraduate students from different streams and $8.1 \%$ of Post Graduate students from P.G. department of Nepali,English,Zoology and Botany participated in the survey.

## TEACHING-LEARNING FACILITIES (EDUCATIONAL FEEDBACK)

The regularity of the class is important for any students to complete their courses in time. $92 \%$ responded that they do attend the classes regularly. Only $1 \%$ of them responded that they attend class twice a week and $6 \%$ of them thrice a week. And only $1 \%$ of the students attend class once in a week .

The regularity of the class is further supported by the communication of cancellation of classes in advance by the teachers to the students as such classes can be used by the other faculty members who are present in the department. $34 \%$ responded that they are informed in advance regarding the cancellation of the class while $27 \%$ responded that they do not get informed regarding such. While 39 \% responded that they do sometimes gets informed regarding cancellation of classes in advance.

A total of $54 \%$ of students responded positively that the syllabus gets covered in a given time frame followed by $31 \%$ who responded that about 70 to $84 \%$ of the syllabus is covered in a given time.

## SYLLABUS COVERAGE IN GIVEN TIME



The availability of teachers is important in the department even after the class time for clarification. Hence $65 \%$ responded that teachers are always available in the department even after the class period followed by $34 \%$ that they do find some teachers in the department after the class time. Only $1 \%$ of students responded in negative.

As per the regulation so of University of North Bengal, the attendance of $75 \% \wedge$ is a must for a student to sit for an examination, hence prompting the need to maintain proper attendance
records. $93 \%$ of students responded that teachers do maintain regular attendance while $1 \%$ responded in negative. $6 \%$ also responded that the teachers do sometimes maintain the record.

For 53\% of students' teachers do provide them with career guidance while $9 \%$ did not receive any such guidance. $38 \%$ of students responded that they did sometimes get the assistance.

$58 \%$ of the students found that the teachers do always encourage them to participate in the discussions in the class. While $4 \%$ did not find the encouragement by the teachers. $38 \%$ of the responded that they do sometimes gets the encouragement.

1. The need of smart room classes has been felt for a long time. Preparing more smart room classes to aid the students in their studies remains a top priority.
2. Encouragement to the students to go to the library and make use of most of the resources.
3. Maintain hygiene in the washrooms of the College.
4. Solve the problem of drinking water facilities in the college.
5. Awareness among students regarding the Grievance Redressal Committee.
6. The College Placement Cell needs to be more active and help students in their career advancement.
7. The internet facilities in the College needs to be upgraded.
8. Encouraging the Students to partake in the extracurricular activities.
9. Encourage more students to participate in NCC and NSS.

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
