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Student Satisfaction Survey Report

(2022-2023)

Student satisfaction surveys are an important tool for measuring the effectiveness of education and identifying areas for improvement. By gathering feedback from students about their experiences in the classroom, the College can gain valuable insights into what is working well and what needs to be changed. The Institution regularly takes feedback from the students regarding teaching -learning experience and College Infrastructure. This feedback helps the College to work on the shortcomings in its work as well as to make informed decisions about curriculum development, teaching methods, and resource allocation.

Conducting a student satisfaction survey can also improve communication and build trust between students and teachers. By giving students a voice and actively seeking their input, educators can demonstrate that they are committed to creating a positive learning environment. This can increase student engagement and motivation, leading to improved academic performance and greater student success.

The College resumed the offline classes in the month of November 2021. The opening of classes after the prolonged period of Covid-19 induced lockdown led to the blended mode of teaching-learning. Both the online and offline classes started simultaneously. This feedback survey is focused on both the online and offline mode of teaching-learning.

THE RESONDENTS

The Student Satisfaction Survey for the year 2022-2023 was conducted with the help of the questionnaire survey. A total of **1532** students out of 2484 attempted the questionnaire and gave us feedback on the teaching-learning and infrastructural facilities of the college. **About 62** % of Students responded to the feedback from both the Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses.

The questionnaire was divided into three heads- teaching-learning facilities (Educational feedback), Administrative Infrastructure and Support and Extracurricular activities.

58.9% of Undergraduate students from different streams and 85.6% of Post Graduate students from P.G. department of Nepali, English, Zoology and Botany participated in the survey.


Students from all streams B.A. Honours (41.6%), B.A. General (28%), B.Sc. Hons (26.3%), B.Sc. General (1.5%), B.Com Hons (1.5%) and B.Com General (1.1%) participated in the survey.

The survey was conducted at the end of EVEN academic session. Hence the participation from 2nd semester students (34.2%), 4th Semester students (30.3%) and 6th Semester students (35.5%) were almost similar. About 65.2% of the respondents were female and only 34.8% of respondents were male. Students from all over the state do study in the College and a tiny portion (1.6%) come from the neighboring states of Assam and others. Most of the respondents (94.5%) are staying as "Paying Guest" and in rented rooms in and around the college and 5.4% reside in the Hostels of the College.

TEACHING-LEARNING FACILITIES (EDUCATIONAL FEEDBACK)


The regularity of the class is important for any students to complete their courses in time. 90.6 % responded that they do attend the classes regularly. Only 0.9 % of them responded that they attend class twice a week and 8.1 % of them thrice a week. And only 0.4 % of the students attend class once in a week .

The regularity of the class is further supported by the communication of cancellation of classes in advance by the teachers to the students as such classes can be used by the other faculty members who are present in the department. 40% responded that they are informed in advance regarding the cancellation of the class while 20.9 % responded that they do not get informed regarding such. While 39.1 % responded that they do sometimes gets informed regarding cancellation of classes in advance.










students responded that teachers do maintain regular attendance while 0.7 % responded in negative. 5.4% also responded that the teachers do sometimes maintain the record.









Administrative and Infrastructure Support





The operation of a library is in the hands of the library staff. The smooth operation of the library is expected to play a huge role in the students' academic development.










60% of students responded positively for the god canteen facilities in the college. However 10 % of students found them poor while 30% found them average in terms of the canteen facilities in the college.




51 % of students responded that the amenities and assistance provided at the college sports ground in good to very good while 29% thinks it is average and 20% of them found it poor.






51% think the college placement Cell is doing their work properly while 9% do not think so and 40% thinks it is just average.




The college premise is clean and maintained properly as per 74.3% of the respondents. While 6.5% of them do not agree and 19.2 % of them couldn't give definite answer.



Extracurricular Activities in the College






