

URGENT NOTICE

The Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, is in receipt of information that a good number of students took admission at the Undergraduate courses in more than one college and/or more than one subject, blocking many seats unnecessarily. As a result, many students are deprived of getting admitted in colleges for want of vacancies. The authorities of all affiliated colleges are hereby requested to collect **declaration** from their admitted students stating that he/she will retain admission in the college of his choice cancelling multiple admissions, if any, by him/her in different colleges for the purpose of registration by the university **within seven days** from the date of notification by the college authority, failing which, it will be presumed that the student has taken multiple admissions. In such cases, the registration of the studentship will be denied/ cancelled by the university authority.

The Principals of all affiliated colleges are requested to submit a status report in this regard within 9th November (forenoon) to the office of the undersigned in his E-mail ID: icnbu@yahoo.com.
